Question: What are minor variations within EU type examined equipment which do not require additional testing / verification?			
Solution: <u>Examples of minor changes:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Change in trade mark- Change in reference- Change in marking <u>Documents to be supplied:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Formal letter from the manufacturer describing the change (s) in the equipment and confirming that there is no further modification- Manufacturers technical specification relative to the change- Sample or specimen <u>Conditions of validity:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Delivery of an EU type examination extension- The extension file is to be kept in the file of the original equipment
