Key words: Category II and category III combined products		
Question: When a category II product has a category III product fitted to it, does the complete assembly have to be subjected to module C2 / D? An example is an industrial helmet, category II, fitted with helmet mounted earmuffs, category III.		
Solution: No. Only the category III product has to be subject to module C2 / D and to be marked with the Notified Body. This will result in the combined PPE having 2 CE marks, one with a Notified Body number and one without. Cross reference RFU 00.005.
