Question: What is the crown area?		
Solution: The crown area can be defined as: <i>“area on the upper outside surface of the helmet which lies within a 30o included solid angle from point G (as defined in EN960:2006, 2.12) on the central vertical axis through the headform on which the helmet is fitted.”.</i>
