| 1) Can protectors without own fastening system comply with the PPE regulation if no appropriate garment (protective) is being defined? | | | |
| 2) Do the defined garments need to be listed in the manufacturer's information? | | | |

| 1) No. At least one suitable garment (e.g. company & article number) must be defined by the protector manufacturer If it is not possible for the protector manufacturer to define at least one suitable garment, an EU Type Examination Certificate cannot be issued. However, the compliance of the protector with the relevant product safety standard may be confirmed with a test report. | | | |
| 2) The defined garment(s) must be documented at least in the test report. and in the user information | | | |
