Key words: Postal address, Marking		
Question: Article 8 "Obligations of manufacturers" of the PPE regulation 2016/425: "Manufacturers shall indicate, on the PPE, their name, registered trade name or registered trade mark and the postal address at which they can be contacted or, where that is not possible, on its packaging or in a document accompanying the PPE. ..."		
Shall the notified Body search for the postal address to be necessarily on the body of a filtering half mask according to EN 149:2001+A1:2009?		
Solution: No PPE regulation gives the possibility to put the postal address on the packaging or in a document accompanying the PPE where it's not possible to mark this postal address on the PPE. Several reasons may explain why marking the filtering half mask is not possible. If the manufacturer decides than marking the postal address on the filtering half mask is not possible, the manufacturer shall clearly states the reasons in the technical documentation on its own responsibility.
