Key words: Marking, partial protection		
Question: How can the marking be made when only a part of garment complies with a standard? <i>Example:</i> The whole garment passes EN ISO 15025 A1level 3 and the requirements for CPC Type 6, but only the front of the garment can be categorized in class D3 for aluminium splashes. Can D3 be put on the marking?		
Solution: It is possible to mark with the number of the standard, if in the marking and information of use it is clearly explained which part of the body is protected.
