<p>Question:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Should PPE against fall from a height subject to ageing be marked with the date of manufacture even if the particular standard does not require this? 2. What shall be the format of the date? 								
<p>Solution:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. YES if obsolescence date is not marked. Note: all PPE against fall from a height subject to ageing shall be marked with the date of manufacture and/or obsolescence date. 2. The date's marking should at least include the year and the month. There is no required format for the date but it shall be explained in instruction for use.
